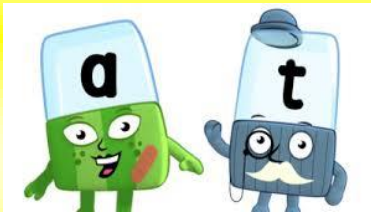

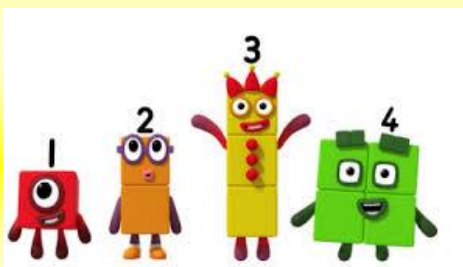


White Rose Maths are providing home learning packages to use during school closures. <https://whiterosemaths.com/>
