



PE

The PE kit that is required for Year 6 consists of the following:

Black Shorts/white T-shirt/pumps for indoor PE.

Black Shorts/leggings/tracksuit bottoms/joggers, white T-shirt/sweatshirt and black trainers for outdoor PE.

Football shirts etc are not allowed.

Please note that for health and safety reasons children should not wear jewellery, especially earrings, in school. Should your child have pierced ears then studs can be worn. The wearing of earrings has caused several serious accidents in Rochdale, occurring both in PE lessons and at break times.

As a result pupils are not allowed to wear earrings for PE and parents/carers are asked to remove them on the morning of PE days.

Breaktime

Please remember to send your child to school in a coat with a hood every day unless it is an exceptionally hot day. If very hot, please put sun cream on your child and send them with a sunhat/cap.

- School doors close: 8.50am
- School Day ends: 3.00pm

If your child arrives late please go to the main school office to sign your child into school as the register will have closed. It is important that your child arrives at school on time as each morning there is a learning activity for them to complete on their arrival.

Please ring in advance if somebody different is picking your child up from school. For the safety of your child, we may not let an unknown person collect your child until we have confirmed this with you.

Uniform

We encourage all children to wear the school uniform. It helps to give a sense of belonging and pride. Please write your child's name on the label of each item of uniform.

Our uniform consists of:

- School jumper
- Grey trousers/grey skirt or pinafore dress
- Grey or white socks
- White shirt/blouse or polo t-shirt
- All black school shoes
- School tie (optional)

Children may not have their heads shaved shorter than a number two; have tram lines, zig zags etc or wear extreme hair fashions of any sort. If parents are unsure about any hairstyle, please contact school. If a child has an inappropriate hairstyle, they will be asked to wear a school cap until it has grown out.

Holidays

Please avoid taking holidays during term time and permission from the Head Teacher is required if you do so. The KS2 SATs will take place during the week commencing 9th May 2022. Prior to this date, preparation for the SATs exams will be carried out on a daily basis.

Sickness

If your child is unwell during the day, a member of staff may ring to inform you or ask you to collect your child if we feel it is necessary. If your child is not well enough to attend school, please ring school at the earliest opportunity to inform us.

For health and safety reasons we should not administer medicines in school. Just occasionally this may be possible, so if your child needs medication for a few days then please see a member of staff to sign a consent slip.



Money



If your child brings money into school, eg for school dinners, or as payment for a trip, please ensure that the money is secured in a labelled envelope to avoid loss.
