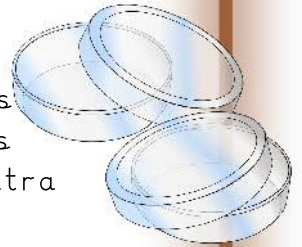




Year 1 Homework - Extraordinary Explorers

Our topic this half term is a history-based topic focussing on the Explorers: Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong, Helen Sharman, Tim Peake, Robert Falcon Scott and Felicity Aston

This homework project should be completed at home over the next few weeks and returned to school on Thursday 9th February. Certificates and dojo points will be issued for those children who complete their homework. There are extra dojos for neat presentation and completing the extra activities.



All these activities should be completed and returned on 9.02.23

- Make a list of essential items for an explorer to help them pack for an adventure
- Imagine you are an explorer and have found a new island. Draw pictures and label the imaginary animals and plants you might find there. (Remember to use your sounds to help you spell and use finger spaces between your words)
- Investigate objects around your house to see which ones float or sink e.g. wooden spoon, metal spoon, bowl, cup etc. (make sure you get your parents permission for this). Record the object, what material it is made from and the result.
- Use a map to find a different country

These are the extra activities that you can choose to do if you wish

- If you haven't done already, bring a picture of you in a place you have explored. It could be in England or another country. We can add it to our classroom map display. (please add which country it is on the back). If you don't have a printer, you can email the picture to the office email and we can print it for you.
- Either make a model or draw a picture of space or a planet
- Bake your own space themed cakes or biscuits. They could be star, rocket or planet shaped (take some photos for us to see)
