We hope you had a lovely Christmas holiday and are looking forward to this term. Here is what we will be looking at over the next few weeks:

Literacy

We will continue with our daily phonic lessons focusing on our Set 3 sounds and we will begin to learn letter names.

We will also continue to learn new spellings weekly linked to sounds we have already met and have daily handwriting lessons. Please try and focus on helping your child to read and spell the red words on their spelling lists as these don't follow a pattern

Numeracy

We will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and will be exploring the place value of numbers to 20. We will then use our addition and subtraction strategies with numbers to 20

Science

We will be using scientific vocabulary to describe the properties of different materials and will be looking at what changes occur in the season Winter

Computing - Programming bee bots

We will be exploring algorithms and creating simple programs for our bee bot to follow.

History

Our topic this term is a history topic all about Extraordinary Explorers - Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong, Tim Peake, Helen Sharman, Robert Falcon Scott and Felicity Aston.

Geography

We will be learning the names of continents linked to our explorers topic
